Can You Stand Next To A Cell Tower And Not Know It?

People put cell phones up to their heads without ever giving a thought to health effects. Phones transmit with about .4 watts of power. EACH cell tower antenna outputs about 100 watts EACH. Four antennas is equal to the power of a microwave oven.

But what about standing too close to a cell antenna at ground level and not know about it? Are there always warning signs posted? How close can you get to one without even knowing it?

Here are a few examples:



FCC warning sign at the base of one cell tower, not seen at all towers. Note how the text leaves out what the actual damage to your health will be from excessive RF radiation. Cataracts in the eyes can be one form of damage. Instead of saying "MAY EXCEED THE FCC PUBLIC EXPOSURE STANDARD " it should read "EXCEEDS PUBLIC EXPOSURE STANDARD."

The department of telecom is soon planning to make more stringent measures for mohile tower installation over buildings and towers in the city, a top retired official of the telecom department said.

city, a top retired official of the telecom department said. Radiation from mobile phones and towers has become a significant risk to public health in urban hubs and cities and the government is trying to work out solutions to solve the problem. "We have proposed 1/10th

of the existing radiation emissions from mobile phone towers over buildings and the proposals will soon be in force. Six metres within the direct range of any mobile tower is a danger zone, but such problems can-not be avoided in a city.

The standards that we had accepted so far were ap-plicable to the United States and now are drawing up our own which will suit Indian conditions and need," former advisor (operations and technology), department of telecommunications, told DNA.

medical professionals were r tower radiations and identify the problem. "Mobile phones have be-come the 21st century ver-sion of cigarettes. When warning cigarette manufac-turers about the dangers of smoking in the early days, nobody listened.

"It was only when cases peaked that it was proved. In the case of mobile phones, one can't see the smoke, can't smell it nor see the damage, but it is causing a huge amount of risk to public health," said IIT professor Girsh Kumar, who has con ducted research on the subject. "Mobile companies need to accept the problem and only then a solution can be

found. It was only when the auto industry accepted that vehicles lead to pollution that solutions were found The key is to accept the prob-lem and identify solutions," he added.

Dr RS Sharma of the In-dian Council of Medical Research said that the govern ment of India was among the countries that had adopted the worst standards of radiation levels.

Ram Kumar, a top retired official from the telecom ministry, said the government was serious about the health hazards of the "We found that radiation

emissions were higher than the norms and that the government had chalked out so lutions to solve the problem The solution lies in using op tic fibre cables and use radi-ation towers of lower power," he added.
